



## CHRIST HOLY SANCTIFIED CHURCH ORDINATION EXAMINATION SCORING SYSTEM

- The scoring system is point based.
- The scoring points will be on a 0 to 5 sliding scale, with 1 point being the minimum number assigned per question and 5 points being the maximum number assigned per question. Zero (0) means the answer is wrong.
- The passing score for each examination will be 3.0 points, meaning that each candidate will have to score at least 3.0 points to pass each examination. If the scored points are 2.99 points or less, the candidate fails that examination and will have to retake that particular examination and score at least 3.0 points in order to pass.
- Some of the questions on the examinations are 1 correct answer questions. For an example, *Who is the highest “ecclesiastical” official of Christ Holy Sanctified Church of America?* The answer is, “The Presiding Bishop/Prelate.” President would be correct as the highest “administrative” or corporate official. Therefore, this question will get 5 points for being correct or zero (0) points if not correct.
- In the scenario of a multi-answer question, the scoring will be on a sliding scale of 0 to 5 points. For an example, “Name the two main founders of the Christ Holy Sanctified Church of America, Inc.” The answer is Judge King and Sarah King. If the candidate gets 1 name correct, he/she will get 3 points (rounded up from 2.5 points). If the candidate does not have either of the two names, their score is zero (0) on that question.
- In the case of the written biblical based examination, the scorers will have to employ skillful judgements in determining the scores, on the sliding scale, based on the candidate’s level of knowledge with regards to their answer(s).
- As the examinations are completed, the examiners will total the number of points on each question, and then divide the total number of points by the total number of questions in that examination; whatever that number comes out to be, that will be the

score for that examination and will determine whether the candidate passed or failed.

Examination score = 2.93 points (failed)

- The candidate (s) will not be approved for ordination until all examinations have been successfully passed with a score of 3.0 or greater.
